



Campus Compact Newman Fellows

Deliberations



Civic engagement means helping students learn how to listen and discuss difficult topics with one another.

We facilitate those discussions using NIFI (National Issues Forum Institute) Issue Guides and Advisories.

In the fall, we hosted one deliberation on Racial Justice which was developed by one of our professors. We had 45 students attend.

In the spring, we are hoping to replicate that success and are hosting two deliberations, one on Policing (NIFI) and the other Racial Justice.

Moderator Training

In order to have successful deliberations, we need Moderators!

Two trainings were/will be offered:

- 1. November 7th, 2021 3-5pm
- 2. April 11th, 2022 3-5pm

We strongly encourage students, staff, faculty all on campus to be trained to assist with facilitating the campus deliberations. This is yet another important skill, to learn to moderate a discussion.

Civic Engagement Board (CEB)

- 1. Serve as the Secretary to the CEB
- 2. Serve on the Voter Engagement Subcommittee of the CEB

The Voter Engagement Subcommittee is more active than the CEB, looking to correct that for the next year.

- E. Working with the **Broome County Board of Elections**: Schedule a program for April/May 2022
