

## **Current COVID-19 Campus Protocols**

In response to updated COVID-19 protocols issued by SUNY, SUNY Broome is adopting the following guidelines regarding weekly testing, mask use, and social distancing on campus effective immediately. These protocols are subject to change as conditions and guidance evolve:

### **Masks and Social Distancing**

- Masks are required for all (vaccinated and unvaccinated) inside campus buildings.
- Unvaccinated or partially vaccinated individuals must continue to wear a mask and maintain social distance, where practicable, from others in all indoor and outdoor settings.
- Nothing in this guidance prohibits fully vaccinated individuals from continuing the use of masks as they wish.

### **COVID-19 Weekly Testing**

- Per the SUNY guidance, mandatory weekly testing will continue to be required for unvaccinated employees and students who have a physical presence on campus, or who have not submitted proof of vaccination. All individuals on campus, regardless of vaccination status, will be tested the first week of classes. Vaccinated individuals are then required to be tested every other week while unvaccinated individuals are required to be tested weekly.
